The Tango's thermodynamic-hydraulic circulation system (picture on the left) is a skilfully crafted work of art, which has been created by local refrigeration engineers and stainless steel welders. The following objects from the Ministat-Unitstat-Tango-inventors' studio are acknowledged thermodynamic and microelectronic works of art. This gallery only displays unique works of art that have not been invented or built in this form, or with this technology, anywhere else in the world.

In the fine arts it is quite common to place great value on the original but because we do have to make a living, thousands* of replicas of the objects displayed here can be found in the better families of the laboratory world. There are alone ten thousand copies of our family's darling, the Ministat, in circulation. The Ministat, Unitstat and Tango are probably better known than the name Huber.
